

Wargrave Surgery is in Top 1 percent of the country

The Wargrave Surgery Patient Participation Group (PPG) in conjunction with the practice issued in January and February 2015 a questionnaire about various aspects of the surgery's service and about local pharmacies and NHS 111.

The detailed Report is available from the Surgery. The Wargrave Surgery GPs have commented that "the partners would like to thank the PPG members for all their hard work in carrying out the patient survey. It is really important to receive patient feedback so that we can continually try and improve patient care".

Tom Berman, Chair of the PPG, said "this survey was sent to over a thousand members of the Wargrave Surgery "Patients Panel" and it received an excellent 30% response. We are very grateful to all those who took the trouble to respond".

The headline conclusion is that "the service provided by Wargrave Surgery is very much above the average for the area. This chimes in with the findings of a national Ipsos MORI survey commissioned by NHS England, covering 7,929 practices nation-wide, which ranked the Wargrave practice as the 33rd best in the whole country".
