Description of the location

We are a four partner practice in a village location with a list size of around 6750 patients. To provide services to our more rural locations we hold two branch surgeries at both Waltham St Lawrence Neville hall and Knowl Hill Village hall twice a week.

Since starting as a single-handed practice in the 1930s, we have grown consistently to keep pace with the expanding needs of the community. Our patient population consists of a good mix from families with young children and young people to middle aged patients and older people who live at home and in local nursing/residential homes.

We operate a strong team structure and endeavour to hear all voices within the team, encouraging ownership, involvement and optimum individual development, working hard at communication and teamwork. We hold regular team meetings to share best practices and increase staff knowledge. We use INPS Vision computer medical records systems and are very proud of our constantly improving records. We aim to be a learning organisation with a shared vision of helping patients.

As a practice we are very committed to high quality patient care and are always evaluating and trying to improve our services. In the last NHS patient survey we are very proud to announce we came 33rd Nationally for patient service. In spite of changes over the last few years with the new contract we have maintained high QOF scores. With having 4 very experienced doctors who work at Wargrave Surgery we have a wide range of skills and knowledge collectively in chronic disease management such as CVD, CHD Asthma, COPD and Diabetes as well as other areas like family planning (including coil and implant fitting) and antenatal care, we also offer Minor surgery. We are interested in life long learning, Dr Kennedy doing Academic work and Dr Thurston currently doing a Masters in Emotional education. Once a week Dr Jackie Moncur holds a general routine surgery. We also have very skilled practice Nurses who specialise in Diabetes, COPD and Asthma. Every Tuesday we hold a baby clinic and once a month Health Visitors join the clinic. The surgery also has a Healthcare Assistant and Phlebotomist who have regular morning surgeries. We are fortunate to have onsite District Nurses and The Community Matron.

Dr James Kennedy is on the LMC and Dr Daniel Alton is member of Wokingham CCG. Dr Puddy is in charge of the Dispensary at the Surgery and Dr Alton looks after Clinical Governance. All partners are members of the RCGP. The Surgery also holds in house training events to ensure staff are fully trained to enable them to carry out their day to day duties.

We dispense to a third of our patients who live more than a mile from the nearest pharmacy.

The surgery has a very large Patient Reference Group and we hold quarterley meetings with the PPG. Wargrave's Patient's Forum is by way the largest of any practice in the area.

We encourage other NHS services to use the surgery as a base, we have a monthly Dietician, weekly stop smoking and physiotherapy sessions and the Midwife has a clinic every two weeks.
